INSTRUCTIONS FOR
OUTDOOR UPHOLSTERY

Cleaning Code W: Clean only with water-based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner. Do not over wet. Do not use dry cleaning solvents to spot clean.

Cleaning Instructions: Most stains on outdoor fabrics can be cleaned up with mild soap and water solution.

- Spot wash by sponging briskly with a solution of natural soap in lukewarm water.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove soap and air dry.
- For stubborn stains, use fabric spot remover. Follow the directions on the container.
- For removable cushion covers, machine wash in cold water with a mild soap, then air dry.
- Solution dyed acrylic does not promote mildew growth. However, mildew may grow on dirt and other

foreign substances that are not removed from the fabric. To clean mildew stains, prepare a mild solution of one cup bleach and two capfuls of natural soap per gallon of water. Spray on entire area and allow to soak in. If necessary, scrub vigorously with a sponge or clean rag. Sponge thoroughly with clean water and air dry.
